Our Philosophy and Aims:

We believe that good doggie manners should start at home, acting on this is what makes us different from other training classes. No more village halls or other dog distractions — we come to you!

The art of good pet dog training is:

- Technique
- Consistency
- Practice

We will not only provide you with a technique which is proven, simple to use and kind to your dog, but also set you up with the tools to maintain consistency across the family and a plan of practice to fit in with your lifestyle.

Training takes place at home at a time that is convenient for you and your family. We offer training from puppy socialisation plans to adult good manners, from pulling on the lead to jumping up. All training is reward based.

Your first visit

This will be a maximum 2 hour assessment of your dog and your requirements. During this we will establish the best plan for you and your dog and get you started.

As part of your first visit, you will receive :

- a free “goodie” bag
- your first clicker to start training
- your dogs’ personalised training pack*
- a follow up phone call

Further visits will last from 45 minutes to 1 hour. These appointments can be booked as a block or on an individual basis to suit you.

*If, on assessment, your dog is deemed to have a behaviour issue requiring behaviour counselling we may advise referral to a dog behaviourist.
